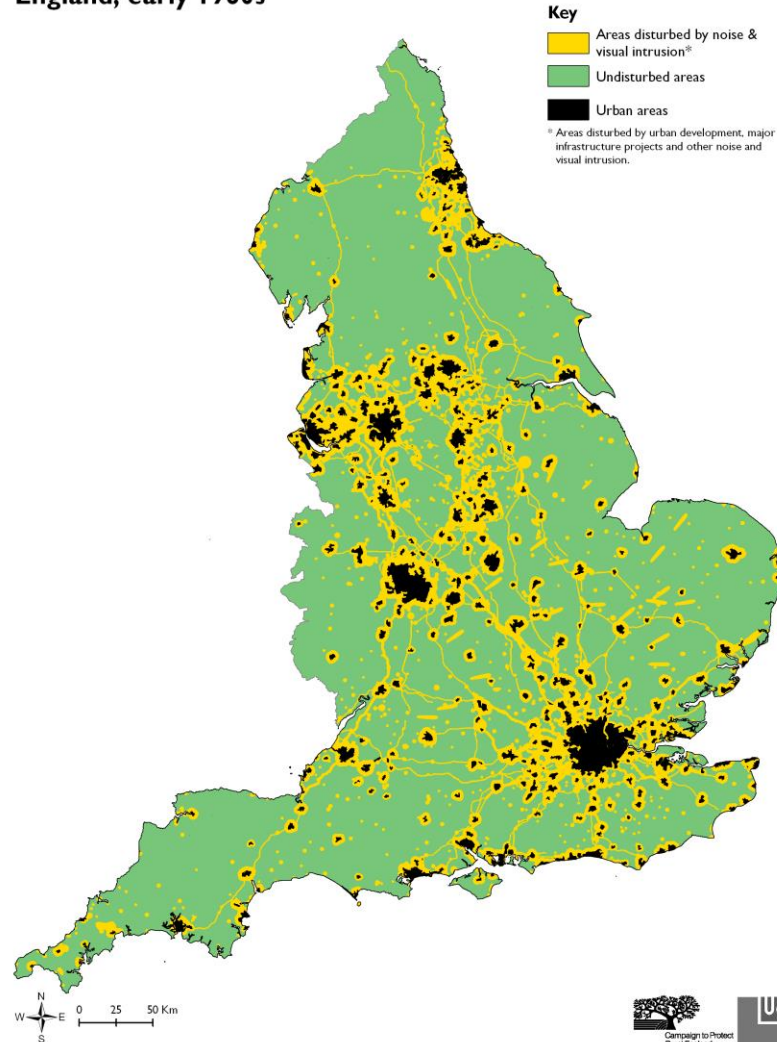

England, early 1960s**

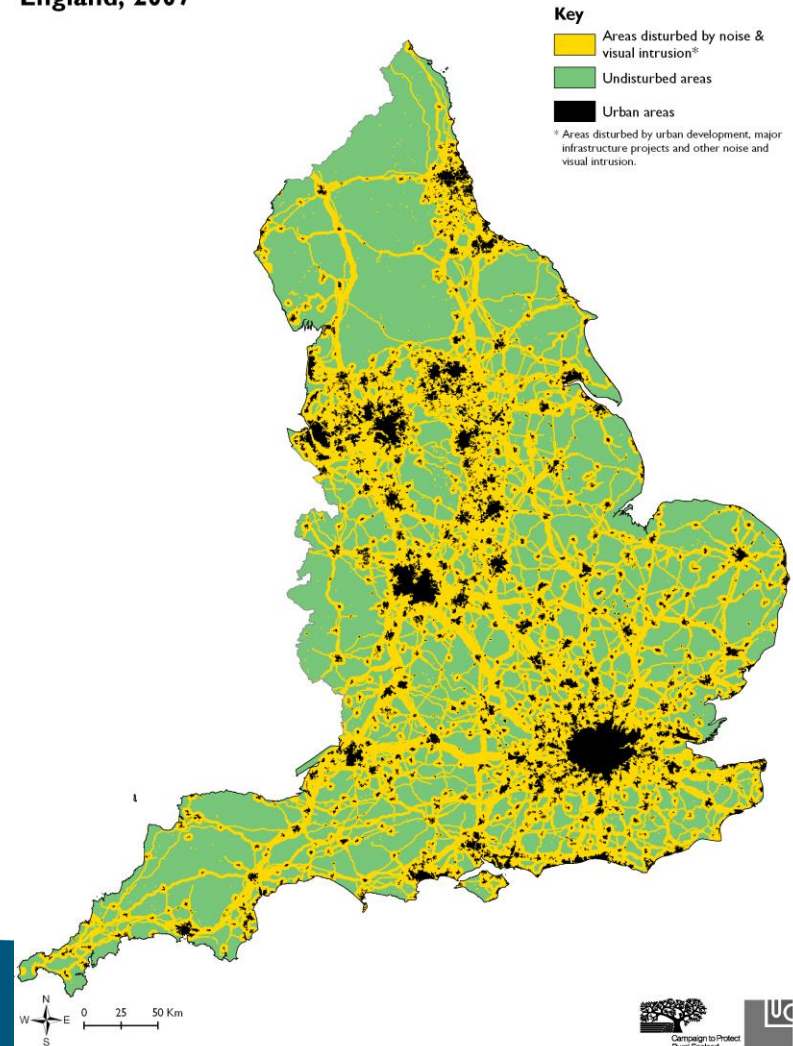

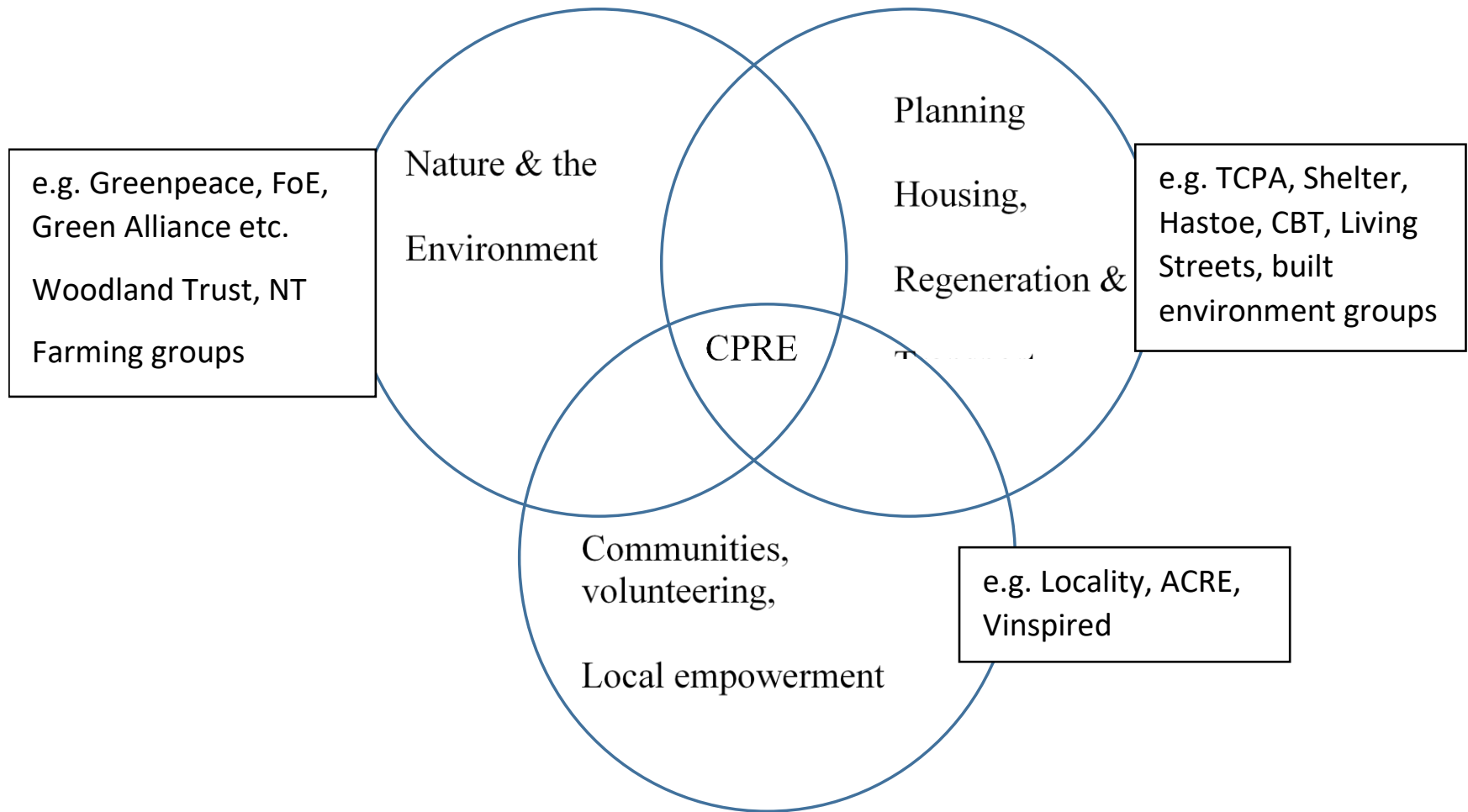
